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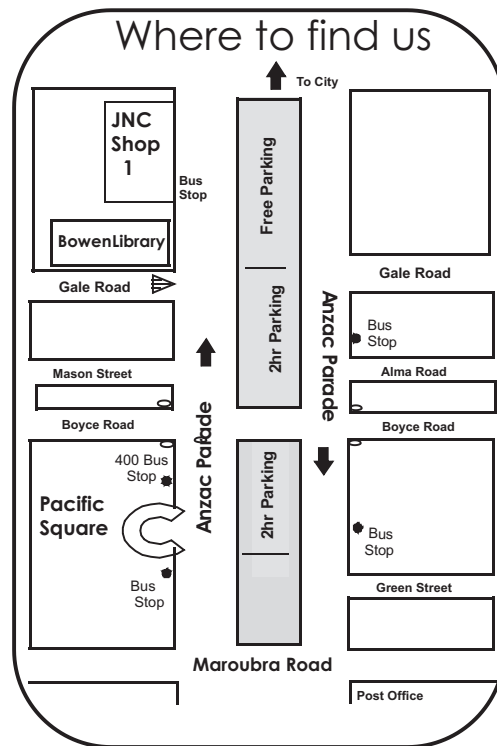

Do you want a service that will listen to you without judgement and support you to find solutions ??

If this sounds like you then please enquire about our Generalist Casework & Advocacy Project by phoning emailing or dropping in to set up an appointment.

Who can access this service?

We welcome all referrals but specialise in the Sydney Eastern suburbs area. People from other areas may be better provided for by a service in their own area. We can help to locate a relevant service or assist as much as possible if no other service can be found.

Service Conditions

Our casework clients are expected to treat our workers with the same level of dignity & respect that we extend to them. Waiting lists may apply and no one is guaranteed service.

Generalist Casework provides someone who will sit down with you and listen. Your caseworker will help you identify the problems, the current barriers to solutions and your intended goals. You will then be provided with all reasonable support to assist you toward achieving these goals. This support may include assisted referral to other services and assistance with forms or advocacy.

The JNC provides generalist casework to our community because we identify it as an unmet need for a high proportion of people within our community. We feel equipped to provide a high standard of service because:
