

Volunteers to assist bus trips or outings

The Volunteer & Service Training (VAST) Program is seeking volunteers to **assist in bus trips or outings** with the elderly and people with disabilities.

We are a **Volunteer Recruitment Agency** providing service to more than 50 not for profit organizations for their volunteer needs. VAST is a program run by JNC.

Our elderly clients often experience loneliness, social isolation and have limited or no contact with family or friends to support them with their needs. A recreational trip is planned on a fortnightly basis to make a difference in the quality of life by giving them an opportunity to socialise and meet other people, share a meal and see interesting places.

Bus trips and outings are also planned for children with disability.

Volunteers assist by helping clients on and off the bus, having a conversation with them, setting up tables for lunch, tea and coffee and serving the meals.

Volunteers from different cultural backgrounds and who can speak different languages other than English are welcome.

Time commitment for this position is approximately 9-3pm every fortnight on a regular basis

Volunteers will benefit by getting an opportunity to socialise with people in the community, improve communication skills and visit new places.

This position is available in following areas for working with children with disability: Maroubra and Edgecliff
